What does the fund invest in?

The investment objective of the Fund is to generate stable risk-adjusted absolute returns consisting of dividends, interest income and capital gains by investing primarily in investment grade corporate debt and debt-like securities with maturities primarily less than 3 years, with a focus on capital preservation. The Fund intends to implement this objective for a limited period of time and will terminate on or about December 31, 2026 or any other date upon providing not less than 60 days' notice to unitholders.

How risky is it?

The value of the Fund can go down as well as up. You could lose money.

One way to gauge risk is to look at how much a fund's returns change over time. This is called "volatility".

In general, funds with higher volatility will have returns that change more over time. They typically have a greater chance of losing money and may have a greater chance of higher returns. Funds with lower volatility tend to have returns that change less over time. They typically have lower returns and may have a lower chance of losing money.

Risk rating

The Manager has rated this Fund's risk as **low**.

Because this is a new fund, the risk rating is only an estimate by the Manager. Generally, the rating is based on how much the Fund's returns have changed from year to year. It doesn't tell you how volatile the Fund will be in the future. The rating can change over time. A fund with a low risk rating can still lose money.

How much does it cost?

The following tables show the fees and expenses you could pay to buy, own and sell Class H units of the Fund. The fees and expenses - including any commissions - can vary among classes of a fund and among funds. Higher commissions can influence representatives to recommend one investment over another. Ask about other funds and investments that may be suitable for you at a lower cost.

1. Sales Charges:

There are no sales charges for the purchase of Class H units of the Fund.

2. Fund Expenses:

You don't pay these expenses directly. They affect you because they reduce the Fund's returns. The Fund's expenses are made up of the management fee, fixed administration fee, operating expenses and trading costs. The Fund's annual management fee in respect of Class H is 0.35%. Because this Fund is new, the operating expenses and trading costs are not yet available. The Manager will be responsible for operating costs of the Fund, other than certain fund costs that are payable directly by the Fund, in exchange for the payment by the Fund of a fixed rate administration fee of 0.07% per annum.

More about the trailing commission

There is no trailing commission payable to your representative's firm for Class H units of the Fund.

3. Other Fees: You may have to pay other fees when you buy, hold, sell or switch Class H units of the Fund.
